To be eligible to participate in Internship, students must have successfully completed a minimum of 9 courses including BUS 130, BUS 150, TMGT 210 and TMGT 230. Students must also have obtained a minimum GPA of 3.0, and completed COOP WEP, prior to the commencement of the internship.

In order to receive a **Certificate in Tourism and Business Internship Designation**, one (1) work term must be completed satisfactorily.
