

# Business Administration Accounting Diploma

**Admission to the Accounting diploma** requires a minimum C+ in English 12 and C in Math 11.

## Diploma Program Content & Requirements

The accounting diploma program consists of 20 courses, 19 mandatory courses and one elective course.

A co-op designation, which is optional, requires two co-op work terms.

## Diploma Elective Course Guidelines

The diploma elective may be any level but if it is a 100 level course, it must be a non-business university transfer course.

If the elective is a two hundred or higher level course it may be a School of Business course or a university transfer course.
