#### Eligibility for Co-op/ Internship Work Experience

To be eligible to participate in Internship or Co-op, students required to successfully complete a minimum of 9 of 11 first year courses, obtain a minimum GPA of 3.0, and a "C" grade in all GOLF courses, complete the workshop series COOP WEP prior to the first work term (Internship) and all subsequent work terms (Co-op).

#### Program Completion Requirements

- To obtain a **Diploma in Golf Management**, you must complete all program courses and obtain a minimum GPA of 2.0 **PLUS** 500 hours of field experience. (*Approved by Program Leader*)
- In order to receive a **Diploma in Golf Management, Co-operative Education Designation**, two (2) Co-op work terms must be completed successfully.
- In order to receive a **Diploma in Golf Management, Internship Designation**, one (1) work term must be completed successfully.

**Note:** Graduates of the two-year Golf Management program can also complete a third year of studies at Camosun to meet the CPGA's Education Requirements.
